The slow, agonizing ascent to the top of the roller coaster, the momentary pause. . . and socko, you're hurtling down the trusty rails at top speed. The Orient Express? No, this thrilling plunge, blurring speed and many more thrills await you at Worlds of Fun's premier attraction for 1981, the 180-degree Incred-O-Dome theater.

More like a thrill ride than a movie theater, the Incred-O-Dome projects intense, audio-visual action upon a mammoth, 180-degree quadrispherical screen. Guests will actually feel as if they are experiencing death-defying thrills without ever leaving the ground.

According to Fitz-Edward Otis of Cinema 180, producers of the Incred-O-Dome film, "We take our viewers to scenic locations they would rarely see otherwise and provide thrills from a vantage point they've probably never experienced. For instance, although a lot of people have seen the Grand Canyon, very few have gone inside it in a helicopter. Our sophisticated 65mm camera equipped with 180-degree lens puts you in the driver's

To insure guests really experience the visual excitement, Cinema 180 hires daredevil photographers and sends them all over the globe to produce the most breathtaking 12 minutes possible. "It may take one week at a particular location to get just one minute of film," Otis explained.

How dangerous are the scenes to shoot? By hiring top-notch stunt pilots and drivers, Cinema 180 personnel have few accidents. However, they once lost a dune buggy to a fiery crash while shooting a fast-paced scene. While filming at Cyprus Gardens in Florida, a mishap occurred when the driver of an airboat hit a stump resulting in a six month hospital stay.

"I guess you could say we go to all lengths to make sure our films are the best," Otis said. "The Incred-O-Dome features include a snowmobile ride in Utah, a helicopter trip under the Golden Gate bridge and around the San Francisco skyline, a high-speed boat chase in Newport Beach, a helicopter ride through the Grand Canyon, a highway car chase near Atlanta and more."

Now that's a lot of traveling in 12 minutes!

A million dollar, park-wide expansion boosts Worlds of Fun's total number of rides, shows and attractions to over 100 and increases the park's hourly ride and show capacity to over 30,000. Abounding with beautiful landscapes and unique attractions, Worlds of Fun is a photographer's paradise. Be sure to record your visit with some focus pocus of your own. If you left your camera at home, free loaners are available from the Snap Shot and Sundries Shop near the main gate.

Here are some DO's and DON'Ts to observe in creating a photographic remembrance of your day at Worlds of Fun:

DO take advantage of interesting settings and unique backdrops throughout the park. The Cotton Blossom and Victrix provide endless opportunities for a creative photographer.

DO consider "before" and "after" ride shots for an interesting personal glimpse.

DON'T have your group face the camera on every shot. Try to capture natural, spontaneous situations to make your snapshots live.

DO keep your elbows tucked in while holding the camera to your eye in a crowded area. Also, a sunshade will help to prevent the stray hands or clothes from rubbing against the lens.

DON'T frame your shot in the path of other guests. You may end up with a passerby as the focus of your attention.

DO watch for interesting people in the spirit of a day of fun. You might see youngsters mesmerized by the fierce curves of the Orient Express or a grandma wrestling with sticky

DO use a high speed film such as ASA 400 with a shutter speed of 1/500 or 1/1000 of a second and apertures of F11 or smaller to avoid blurring when shooting a ride. Of course, if you wish to indicate movement, use a slower shutter speed.

DO experiment with various locations to capture just the right angle for shooting a ride. Capture the expanse of the ride with a wide angle lens and the excitement in the faces of the passengers with a telephoto lens.

DON'T pass up chance encounters with Worlds of Fun's official ambassadors, Sam Panda, Grrrtrude Gorilla or Dan'l Coon.

DO look for a novel way to put a "signature" on your photo record. Shots that clearly indicate a visit to Worlds of Fun provide a start and finish like a good short story.

DO take advantage of the Spittin' Image tintype photographers for an official group portrait that you, the photographer, can be in too.

DON'T forget to check the post card collection at a souvenir stand before you leave. You might find a shot you missed.

DO make sure you have lots of film (and the camera is loaded) and DO take the lens cover off the camera. If this reminder comes too late, DON'T forget the post cards.

LAMAR HUNT

Although better known for his professional sports endeavors, Lamar Hunt has also been successful as the owner and chairman of Kan-sas City's Worlds of Fun. The Kansas City Chiefs, World Championship Tennis, Dallas Tornado soccer and Chicago Bulls başketball are among Hunt's sports interests, but it's sports of a different kind at Worlds of Fun where the "fans" ride roller coasters and the like.

Hunt looks upon the multi-million dollar investment in Worlds of Fun as a "dividend" for Kansas City resulting from the popular support of his Kansas City Chiefs Football Club. Since 1973, this dividend has generated over 19,000 jobs for area youth and drawn over 5.5 million tourists to the Kansas City area. Because of Worlds of Fun's and the Chiefs'

success. Hunt has continued to invest in Kansas City. Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc., formed in 1980, has become the corporate holding company for Worlds of Fun and Great Midwest Corporation, a diversified company acquired last year that is involved in surface and underground development, mining and pipeline construction.

Hunt is active in community and civic af-fairs both in his hometown of Dallas and in Kansas City. In addition, he is an enshrinee and member of the board of trustees of the Pro Football Hall of Fame, a member of the na-tional board of trustees of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes as well as a member of the board of directors for the NFL Charities and the National Park Foundation.

JACK STEADMAN
Development of Worlds of Fun has been a long-term project for Jack Steadman, president of the 157-acre family theme park. Steadman began to develop his dream of an internationally-themed park after a family trip to Dis-neyland in 1957. The concept became a reality

on May 19, 1973 and under Steadman's direction has continued to grow as evidenced by annual expansion that has boosted the original

ride and show capacity by 67%.

Considered to be one of the top administrators in professional sports, Steadman became general manager of the Dallas Texans in 1960 and in 1963 engineered the team's move to Kansas City. In 1976, he was named president of the Chiefs.

Steadman is active in numerous local business, charitable and civic organizations. In addition to being chief executive of the Kansas City Chiefs, Steadman is also president of Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc. which owns both Worlds of Fun and Great Midwest Corporation, the real estate and underground development firm in the Kansas City International Trade Zone. He is also a vice president of the First Fidelity Liquidating Trust and a member of the board of directors of Commerce

In 1981, Steadman will serve as the president of the Heart of America United Way, an organization which will raise over \$15 million this year to support 130 local charitable agencies. His other civic endeavors include participation on the executive committee and board of directors of Starlight Theatre, Children's Mercy Hospital and the American Royal Association. Steadman is also a member of the Civic Council of Greater Kansas City, the Kansas City Area Economic Development Council, and an advisory trustee of the Research Medical Center.

LEE DERROUGH

Managing the day-to-day activities of a 157acre theme park with 100-plus attractions, a work force of 1,500 and an annual guest attendance of over 1,400,000 can hardly be considered ordinary. It guarantees long hours and requires a penchant for quality, a creative ap-





They have provided us with an unencumbered working environment and the capital necessary to attain the physical expansion and attendance increases we have been so fortunate to enjoy," states Derrough. "Jack and Lamar's confidence and perseverance, the hard work and dedication of our permanent staff, and the enthusiasm of our seasonal ambassadors have made Worlds of Fun one of the nation's most successful and respected themed amusement park opera-tions. Derrough serves on the board of directors of Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc., and Mid-America Enterprises, Inc. He is a member of the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions; secretary/treasurer of the Clay County Development Commission; secretary/treasurer of the Convention and Visitors Bureau of Greater Kansas City; vice president of the Missouri Travel Council; and member of the Chamber of Commerce of Greater Kansas City. Derrough is a graduate of the University of Kansas. He is 36 years old and makes his home in Kansas City, Missouri.
