

Welcome to Our World

For the great times . . . A Worlds of Fun Passport opens the door to the best entertainment value anywhere. The one-price admission for a day-long excursion includes rides, shows, attractions and special events. A two-day visit is suggested for a more leisurely pace.

For a season-long entertainment package, you'll want a Worlds of Fun Season Passport or a Worlds of Fun/Oceans of Fun Combination Season Passport. Both are available at the Passport Services booth located at the main entrance.

Special rates are available to groups of 25 or more. For further information, call (816) 454-4545, ext. 222; or write Worlds of Fun, Group Sales, 4545 Worlds of Fun Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri 64161.

Lots of lots... Please observe the lot and row number where you park so you will be able to find your car after your visit. If you want to leave the parking lot and return the same day, present your numbered parking ticket at Guest Relations for validation. Tram Service is provided for your convenience to transport you from your car to the main entrance.

What to wear? Worlds of Fun's dress is always casual, but shoes and shirt are required.

It's a Dog's Life... The European plan is available for your vacationing dog or cat at the air-conditioned kennel (tram stop #1). Free lodging and meals for your pets are provided by Holiday Science Diet, and an attendant is on duty at all times. Take advantage of this fine facility. Pets are not permitted in the park.

Ouch! The First Aid station is located in the Scandinavian section near the Schussboomer roller coaster. Our first aid staff is on duty at all times. The first aid staff cannot dispense any medication, but aspirin and other non-prescription items can be obtained at Snap Shot Shop.

May we help you? Ambassadors at Guest Relations are always available to cash checks, make hotel reservations, take suggestions and provide many other services. Feel free to stop by the office located on the S.S. Henrietta at the main entrance.

Rain, Rain, Go Away! Worlds of Fun remains open under nearly all weather conditions. For guests' safety some rides must close briefly during more severe weather. Refunds and rain checks are not issued because there are a variety of shows, rides and other attractions that are unaffected by the weather.

Charge! Worlds of Fun honors American Express, Visa and MasterCard at the ticket booths and most shops throughout the park. In order to provide prompt service, we cannot accept credit cards at restaurants and food stands.

Show me the way . . . Large, colorful posters will guide you through Worlds of Fun. Or, you can purchase a map at souvenir shops located throughout the park.

Lock it up! Lockers, located near the main entrance, allow you to store items you don't wish to carry with you. We ask that you leave bottles, cans or coolers in your car or bus.

Smile! Free cameras are available for your use at the Kodak Snap Shot Shop, located in the Americana section near the main entrance.

Reach out and touch someone...Public telephones are located near most restrooms and at the main entrance.

Where's Junior? Small children separated from their parents are taken to the Lost and Found Caboose, located in the Americana section. Ambassadors are on duty to entertain children until their family shows up to claim them.

Meet'cha later . . . Worlds of Fun does not provide a personal paging system. Before your group separates, make plans to meet at a specified time and place.

That's Show Biz... Nearly six hours of different live shows are performed daily. Show schedules are published daily and distributed at the parking toll plaza (extra copies available at Guest Relations). Map cases also list daily show times.

Catch a ride . . . A limited supply of free strollers for small children are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Most can be found inside the main entrance. Wheelchairs can be obtained by reservation only.

Dial-a-Star . . . Top name performers present live shows throughout the season. Call the Worlds of Fun phone (816) 454-4444 for current listings.

Ups & Downs . . . For guest's safety, height restrictions (some maximum, some minimum) are posted on several rides and attractions and children must be accompanied by an adult on certain rides.

Picnicking... Picnic Hollow, located outside the Scandinavian exit, welcomes families and groups to bring picnic lunches. We cannot permit picnics in the parking area or the park.

Late Lunch? To beat the crowds, plan meals a bit earlier or later than usual. You'll find fewer people at our restaurants and snack stands.

What's my Line? Line jumping is discourteous and strictly prohibited. Violators are subject to dismissal from the park.

City of Fountains: Restrooms and drinking fountains can be found in every section of the park. Ask any ambassador for directions.

If you can't find it . . . Lost articles can be claimed or reported at the Lost and Found Caboose located near Front Street.

Car Trouble, anyone? If you have any problems with your car, raise the hood and contact a parking lot attendant. A courtesy vehicle will be by shortly to offer assistance.

For Babies Only . . . Baby's bottle warming is available for infants at the Smor Bord and Cafe Internationale.

Come Back, Soon! During peak exiting hours, you might save time by walking from the park to the parking lot. Use the Scandinavian walkway, which has been provided for this service.

* * * * TWENTY QUESTIONS, ANYONE? * * * *

If you are ready to make a big splash at Oceans of Fun, but have a few questions on your mind, this guide is for you!

- 1)Q: What is included in the price of admission to Oceans of Fun?
 - A: A single-day Passport is \$10.50 (plus tax) and entitles you to a full day of unlimited use of Oceans of Fun's attractions. A two-day Passport is available for \$14.50 (plus tax) and offers double the fun for two consecutive days. Children three years of age and younger are always admitted free.
- 2)Q: I want to visit both Oceans of Fun and Worlds of Fun. What do I do?
 - A: A Combination Passport is only \$19.75 (plus tax) and entitles you to a full day of fun at both parks. Combination Passports may be purchased at the Guest Services Booth at either park.
- 3)Q: Are group discounts available?
 - A: Groups of 25 or more may take advantage of special rates by calling (816) 459-9222, or writing Oceans of Fun, Group Sales, 4545 Worlds of Fun Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri 64161.
- 4)Q: Can I bring my pet duck?
 - A: There are no facilities provided for pets at Oceans of Fun, even for animal quackers!
- 5)O: What do I do with my car?
 - A: A parking area is available, but don't forget to note your location before parting with your vehicle. If you desire to leave the parking lot and return the same day, present your parking ticket at Guest Relations for validation. A copy of Great Times magazine is included in the parking fee.
- 6)Q: What if I parked at Worlds of Fun when I meant to park at Oceans of Fun or the other way around, if you know what I mean?
- A: If you find yourself in the wrong parking lot, don't panic. Just go to the Guest Relations Booth nearby and they'll help you get to the correct place.

- 7)Q: Can I charge my day of fun?
 - A: Oceans of Fun honors American Express, MasterCard and Visa at Passport booths and most shops. So that service will be speedy, credit cards are not accepted at restaurants and food stands.
- 8)Q: Where is my buddy, General I.N. Formation?
- A: General information will be found at the Guest Relations Booth located at the main gate. It is also here that you may cash a check, find lost children, make hotel reservations, or report things lost or found.
- 9)Q: Shall I wear, or bring, my swimsuit?
 - A: Either way is a-okay. If you choose to dress at the park, rental lockers, dressing rooms and hot showers are located in the men's and women's clubhouses by Trader Nick's shop.
- 10)Q: How can I navigate without a map?
 - A: Maps are available at the main gate, in Trader Nick's shop and at satellite locations throughout the park.
- 11)Q: How can I become a member of the Buccaneer Bay Yacht Club or catch waves on a raft?
 - A: Just choose your vessel from among the sailboats, rowboats, paddleboats and Funyaks that are available on a rental basis. Raft rental is available at George's Rafts located near Surf City or Jolly Roger's near Neptune's Lagoon.
- 12)Q: I'm not afraid of the water, but . . .
 - A: For your safety and enjoyment, highly-trained water safety personnel is on duty at all times in all areas of the park.
- 13)Q: Secondly, what about First Aid?
 - A: The First Aid station is located in the Administrative Building near Surf City. Qualified staff is on duty at all times.

- 14)Q: Is rain a pain?
 - A: Not really, Oceans of Fun operates under almost all weather conditions. Certain attractions, however, may close briefly under more severe conditions for the safety of our guests. Rain checks or refunds cannot be issued.
- 15)Q: Is it "out-of-order" to use your phone?
 - A: Of course not, public telephones are located at the main entrance, the clubhouse and various points throughout the park.
- 16)Q: How high is low?
 - A: For your safety, height restrictions (some maximum, some minimum) are posted at a few attractions.
- 17)Q: May I address the public?
 - A: Oceans of Fun does not provide personal paging. We suggest that you plan a time and place for meeting your friends.
- 18)Q: Where can I find running water around here?
 - A: Drinking fountains and restrooms are found in the clubhouses and at various locations throughout the park.
- 19)Q: May I leave fore . . , and return aft?
 - A: If you wish to leave Oceans of Fun and return later the same day, have your hand stamped as you exit the park and you'll be readmitted at no charge.
- 20)Q: I'm long on fun but short on time, how can I visit both Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun on the same day?
 - A: Simply purchase a Worlds of Fun/Oceans of Fun Combination Passport at the main gate. We suggest you visit Oceans of Fun from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. when the sun is high in the sky. You can enjoy Worlds of Fun later in the day and into the evening.



Where were you in 1973? Remember watching Room 222 and the Watergate hearings on television? Do you recall buying a gallon of gasoline for only 39.9¢ and a loaf of bread for a quarter? That year the sounds of the Who, Elton John, Kenny Rogers and Bread were among the most popular. Headlines announced plans for Kemper Arena; Clarence Kelley's move to Director of the FBI; and the birth of Steve and Terri Busby's first child. Since that inaugural season, you've probably noticed many additions. If you visited in 1974, you may have been among the first to enjoy the Forum Amphitheatre. In 1975, the Forum was expanded to encompass over 4,000 seats and to date has hosted a variety

of the nation's top entertainers like Loretta Lynn, Eddie Rabbit, Kenny Rogers and Hall & Oates.

And in 1976, Worlds of Fun guests celebrated the nation's 200th anniversary at the Bicentennial Square. Daredevil visitors thrilled to the latest in roller coasters . . . the Screamroller.

When you visited the park in 1977, you were in for quite a surprise as Worlds of Fun sported an all-new look. Major new rides were added in all five sections of the park.

MEET A FEW OF OUR FAVORITE PEOPLE

Lamar Hunt - Although better known for his professional sports endeavors, Lamar Hunt has also been successful as the owner of Kansas City's Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun. World Championship Tennis, Dallas Tornado soccer and Chicago Bulls basketball are among Hunt's sports interests, but it's sports of a different kind at Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun where the "fans" ride roller coasters, water slides and the like.

Hunt looks upon the multi-million dollar investment in the two family theme parks as a "dividend" for Kansas City resulting from the popular support of his Kansas City Chiefs Football Club. Since 1973, this dividend has generated over 22,000 jobs for area youth and drawn over 6.5 million tourists to the Kansas City area.

Because of Worlds of Fun's and the Chiefs' success, Hunt has continued to invest in Kansas City. Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc., formed in 1980, has become the corporate holding company for Worlds of Fun, Oceans of Fun and Great Midwest Corporation — a diversified company involved in surface and underground development, mining and pipeline construction.

Hunt is active in community and civic affairs both in his hometown of Dallas and in Kansas City. In addition, he is an enshrinee and member of the board of trustees of the Pro Football Hall of Fame, a member of the national board of trustees of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes as well as a member of the board of directors for the NFL Charities and the National Park Foundation.

Jack Steadman · Worlds of Fun has been a long-term project for lack Steadman, chairman of lid-America Enterprises. Steadan began to develop his dream of an internationally-themed park after a family trip to Disneyland in 1957. The concept became a reality on May 19, 1973 and under Steadman's management has grown into the multi-faceted entertainment complex Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun has become today.

Considered to be one of the top administrators in professional sports, Steadman became general manager of the Dallas Texans in 1960 and in 1963 engineered the team's move to Kansas City. In 1976, he was named president of the Chiefs.

Steadman is active in numerous local business, charitable and civic organizations. In addition to being president of the Kansas City Chiefs, Steadman is also president of Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc. which owns Mid-America Enterprises, developers of Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun, and Great Midwest Corporation, a mining, real estate and underground development. He is also vice president of the First Fidelity Liquidating Trust and a member of the board of directors of Commerce Bank.

Steadman is the chairman of the board of directors of the Heart of America United Way, an organization which raised over \$17 million this year to support 137 local community service agencies. His other civic endeavors include participation on the executive committee and board of directors of Starlight Theatre, Children's Mercy Hospital and the American Royal Association. Steadman is also a member of the Civic Council of Greater Kansas City, the Kansas City Area Economic Development Council and an advisory trustee of the Research Medical Center.

Lee Derrough · As President of Mid-America Enterprises, Lee Derrough handles the overall management, direction and coordination of the company's combined business entities.

During the last ten years, Lee Derrough and his staff have orchestrated an impressive growth pattern for Worlds of Fun. The park's number of attractions has risen from 60 to over 110, annual attendance has increased 62% and total attendance has reached 10.8 million with 60% of those visitors coming from outside the Kansas City metropolitan area.

It was Derrough who first visualized a family water recreation park for Kansas City. His perseverance has made Oceans of Fun a reality.

To what does Derrough attribute the success of Kansas City's family entertainment complex? "The continued growth and acceptance of Worlds of Fun and the development of Oceans of Fun has been possible due to the unwavering support and involvement of the park's owners, Lamar Hunt and Jack Steadman. They have provided us with an unencumbered working environment and the capital necessary to attain the physical expansion and attendance increases we have been so fortunate to enjoy," states Derrough. "Jack's and Lamar's confidence and perseverance, the hard work and dedication of our permanent staff and the enthusiasm of our seasonal ambassadors have made Worlds of Fun one of the nation's most successful and respected family theme park operations and made it possible for us to create Oceans of Fun. We are all very proud of those achievements."

In addition to his duties as president of Mid-America Enterprises, Inc., the 37-year old Derrough serves on the board of directors of Hunt Midwest Enterprises, Inc. He is also chairman of the board of directors of the Convention and Visitors Bureau of Greater Kansas City, a member of the boards of directors of the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions, the Clay County Development Commission and the Commerce Bank of Clay County, and a member of the Chamber of Commerce of Greater Kansas City and the Executive Committee of the Travel Federation of Missouri.

David Busch - For General Manager David Busch, an association with Worlds of Fun and Mid-America Enterprises began at an early age as he first worked for the Kansas City Chiefs while a high school student. Having held several key positions at Worlds of Fun over the last decade has given him the necessary experience to oversee one of America's premier family theme parks.

Managing the day-to-day activities of a 158-acre theme park with over 110 attractions, a work force of 1,700 and an annual guest attendance of 1.4 million, can hardly be considered ordinary. It guarantees long hours and requires a penchant for quality, a creative approach to problem solving and endless enthusiasm.

Busch's positive outlook and success-philosophy influences the entire park operation as he encourages others to meet every challenge with a "can-do" attitude.

A lifelong Kansas City resident, Busch is vice president of the Kansas City Philharmonic Association, serves on the executive boards of the Clean City Commission and the Whatsoever Community Center, and is a member of the Chamber of Commerce of Greater Kansas City Meetings Committee, the Mayor's Corps of Progress and the Task Force Against Crime.
