


o launch its twentieth year of operation,
Worlds of Fun is embarking on one of the largest capital improvement projects in the park's history. The \$4.1 million expansion project includes a spill water ride built between both parks, a "superpool" at Oceans of Fun and a SameDay Gateway to link the entertainment complex.

Topping the list of projects is the **Monsoon**, located between Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun. For the first time visitors can experience an attraction from both parks. Guests board a 20-passenger boat that slowly ascends up a 50-foot lift hill. After a brief pause, passengers plunge down a cascading waterfall, accelerating up to 35 mph into a 425,000 gallon lagoon that creates a 40-foot tall wave of water.

A major new "superpool" entitled **Coconut Cove** is planned for the opening of Oceans of Fun on May 23. Coconut Cove features over 20,000-square-feet of cool, blue water, where kids and adults alike can ride a friendly shark, walk on a lily pad path or float on an oversized snake.

The SameDay Gateway, a convenient new passageway connecting the two

parks, makes it easy to reach the other park within minutes. Separate admission to the two parks is

required. However, discounted admission rates will be available whenever both parks are open. Since it first opened,
Worlds of Fun has grown so much
it barely resembles the park
guests visited that first year!
When the first guests arrived on
May 26, 1973, traditional favorites
like the Zambezi Zinger, Viking
Voyager and Tivoli Music Hall
were already in place among 60
other fun rides, shows and attrac-

tions. Nearly all the original attractions are still in operation, but several have changed their look and name GATEWAY over the vears. However, the biggest changes have come as part of the park's ongoing expansion programs like the Timber Wolf and Beat Street.

Today, Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun have blossomed into over 230 acres featuring more than 170 rides, shows and attractions.

Twenty Years of Making Magic



t was a day when antique

bi-planes flew, thousands of balloons were released, and a small family fun park known as Worlds of Fun opened for its first day of operation. It was May 26, 1973.

Worlds of Fun

Years earlier Worlds of Fun was just a dream – a vision of Lamar Hunt, President of the Kansas City Chiefs Football Club, and Jack Steadman, the executive vice president and general manager of the Chiefs.

Designed around Jules Verne's book "Around the World in Eighty Days," Worlds of Fun features five uniquely themed areas – Americana, Scandinavia, Africa, Europa and Orient.

The historic Cotton Blossom stern-wheel riverboat was purchased at a movie auction at Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer's studios. The boat was dismantled and shipped to Worlds of Fun in six box cars. Following reconstruction and refurbishment, the 3-deck, 170-foot boat became a magnificent landmark shopping attraction in the Americana section.

Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun are one of the area's largest employers, employing over 3,400 youths and adults each season. In nineteen years, the entertainment complex has employed over 56,000 men and women. Worlds of Fun has entertained 23,899,523 visitors in its nineteen years.

In 1974 the Forum Amphitheatre, the home of Worlds of Fun's superstar concerts, was completed.

In 1975 the Bicentennial Square was introduced featuring games

and the Screamroller, a sevenstory high, double-loop roller coaster.

In 1977, something new was added at every turn. The Bamboozler was added to the Orient section, the Wobble Wheel to the Americana section, the Micro Moto Bahn to the Scandinavian section and the Bounce-A-Roos to the Europa.

The Aerodrome section was added in 1978. The Zulu was added to the African section in 1979 along with the Beetle Bumps in the Orient section and Le Carrousel in the Europa section.

In 1980, the park debuted the unique Orient Express steel roller coaster, which takes riders down a 115-foot drop at 65 mph and through two interlocking loops.

The Incred-O-Dome Theatre, a sight and sound film spectacular, was added in 1981.

Worlds of Fun celebrated its 10th anniversary in 1982 by adding the River City section and the 1,000-seat County Junction Amphitheatre located in the Americana section.

The Fury of the Nile river raft ride was completed in 1984. And in 1985, the first edition of the Stax of Wax rock 'n' roll review opened, as did the 1,000-seat Festhaus picnic pavilion in Scandinavia, home to hundreds of annual company picnics. 1986 brought the Omegatron, a six-story, upside-down thrill ride. In 1987, the Aerodrome section was renovated into Pandamonium, a special area just for kids.

In 1988, Worlds of Fun introduced the Python Plunge, four lightning-quick hydroflumes to the African section.

The Timber Wolf wooden roller coaster was unleashed in 1989. Featuring over 4,230 feet of spinetingling terror, a 95-foot drop and an upward spiraling helix, it has been rated the #1 coaster in the world.

In 1991, the River City section was renovated to become Beat Street, a modern day Coney Island, featuring the Rockin' Reeler and the Skyliner.

Today, Worlds of Fun encompasses over 170 acres featuring over 140 rides, shows and attractions.

Since its opening in 1982, Oceans of Fun has entertained nearly 3 million guests. Oceans of Fun attractions include:

Coconut Cove



Coconut Cove, a 20,000-squarefoot "superpool," is an adventure for the entire family. Where else can you ride a friendly shark, walk on a lily pad path or float on an oversized snake?

Buccaneer Bay & Beach

One of the world's longest dual water speed slides delivers over 400 feet of action at speeds up to 30 mph.

BEST OF THE BEST

orlds of Fun's best known ride is the Timber Wolf roller coaster. The Timber Wolf is a 4,230-foot long wooden roller coaster. The 2.5-minute journey begins as the coaster train takes its passengers out of the station for a 25-degree climb to 100 feet above the ground, then turns a tight corner and plummets 95feet toward the earth at 50degrees and 53 mph. Riders experience a +2.85 G-force.

Suddenly the train lifts its passengers upward for a near negative G-force of .01, then slams into a high-banking curve to the left, and zooms downward at speeds reaching 49 mph, and a G-force peaking at +2.73.

> Cresting hills and valleys, the train speeds through the awesome wooden structure, then

races into the helix at a speed of 44 mph where it spirals twice through a 120-foot loop while banking severely to the right.

The train dives out of the helix at a speed of 40 mph with a +2.48 G-force, travels through the wooden structure into a circuit of sharp curves then enters the hairpin curve and a 180-degree turn that brings the train into the brake system before coasting into the station.

The Timber Wolf's 1,200 concrete piers support 15 tons of nails, 80,000 bolts and 680,000 board feet of lumber.

The Timber Wolf is currently rated the number-one roller coaster in all the world by readers of Inside Track, an international newsletter for coaster enthusiasts. Designed by Curtis D. Summers, Inc., of Cincinnati, Ohio, the Timber Wolf was built in 1989 by the Charles Dinn Corporation also of Cincinnati, Ohio.

To keep Worlds of Fun's sevenmonth season and Oceans of Fun's three-month season in bloom, the Landscaping department begins each new season by planning for it in October of the previous year by planting over 3,000 tulip bulbs.

Continual care is required to maintain the 180-acre perennial plant haven with over 180,000 plants, flowers and trees. Landscape design has been a predominate consideration, beginning with initial construction of the park in 1969

According to Sean Johnson, long-time veteran of the landscaping department, "We try to maintain the area motif with plant material that is a part of each area's native foliage."

For example, many of the trees have been transplanted to complement the parks' unique world themes. Such trees as American pin oak, European sycamore, African dracaena, Norwegian spruce, tropical coconut palm trees and Japanese dogwood are appropriately placed to highlight each themed area.

Hanging baskets containing a variety of ferns, begonias, petunias and ivy and pots of roses, tropical foliage and cacti are dramatically beautiful, but can present special problems for the landscape staff. When Worlds of Fun first opened in 1973, several large tropical plants were brought to the park from California and Florida in addition to dozens of small stock. When they grew too large to maintain during the winter, they had to be sold. Maintaining a

stock of palm trees, workers have seen many of the palms grow to the roof of the greenhouses.

Two salaried supervisors, 14 full-time and 59 seasonal employees work throughout the day and night to "make the landscape at both parks healthy, attractive, and clean," according to Johnson.

One characteristic of the Americana section is the cactus display. "The cactus collection is actually owned by one of our specialists, Steve Youngstrom," Johnson said.

"Tve got over 500 cacti representing over 250 different varieties," Youngstrom, the greenhouse specialist, said. "There is hardly any duplication. The key to growing cacti is not over watering the plant. Water can kill a cactus."

"However, water is the crucial element in caring for plants, trees, shrubs and turf," Youngstrom said. "We are constantly watering."


